

***Please keep in mind that what follows is a log from a chat session. Although readings GeminiRose does through *Readings by GeminiRose* are conducted via E-Mail, phone, and chat, this gives the client a good idea as to what kinds of messages come through during a mediumship reading as well as how GeminiRose receives her information in general. Also, please keep in mind that in chat, messages appear on the screen based on which participant hits the “ENTER” key first. Therefore, some of what follows may seem a bit out of order at times. You’ll notice that, occasionally, one line is posted right before the other, but it’s apparent that both GeminiRose and Lily were typing the messages simultaneously.

The following transcript has been shortened since its original length spanned nearly two hours. This means that, for brevity’s sake, other sections with both hits and misses have been taken out. Places where dialogue has been omitted are indicated with an ellipsis (...). This conversation is meant to simply highlight samples from the overall reading. The portions that are here have only been edited to remove casual conversation (of a personal nature that does not necessarily add to the message of the reading) as well as to correct grammar and spelling. Also, Lily’s original screen name has been changed to her real first name.

A Message From GeminiRose:

What follows in this reading are the types of messages that spirits relay to me to share with their loved ones who are still living here on the physical plain. The purpose of their bringing up seemingly trivial childhood incidents is to prove to the client that they are who they say they are. As Lily said in her testimonial, even *she* had forgotten about some of these things. Spirits also point out things that are happening in our present lives, (since their passing), to let us know that they are still around us. Even from the other side, they take joy in being a part of our lives. Whether they are giving us strength during our weakest moments or sharing a breathtaking scene in nature with an invisible arm over our shoulders, they are assuring us that their love is still as real as they are.

GeminiRose: *MSG* This is going to sound crazy.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I keep hearing "Suwannee River" in my head.

Lily: *MSG* Oh, nothing sounds crazy to me.

Lily: *MSG* Really? Odd.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Does that mean anything? I'm trying to decide what it means to me.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Isn't that Florida's song?

Lily: *MSG* My grandparents liked that old music [like that]. They played piano [and] accordion.

GeminiRose: *MSG* So they were very musical?

Lily: *MSG* Yes, they were.

Lily: *MSG* Sadly, I never inherited that.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Okay, connected to that, I'm getting the gardening.

Lily: *MSG* Again, grandparents.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I feel like these were very simple people-

GeminiRose: *MSG* down-home folks.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Like... planting and harvesting turnips

Lily: *MSG* Yes, very much so.

Lily: *MSG* Huge gardens.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I get that the garden was very significant to the home life.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I guess that's their way of connecting to you.

GeminiRose: *MSG* They keep bringing up "the fire".

Lily: *MSG* They grew many crops....

GeminiRose: *MSG* Did they lose part of their home to a fire... or this has somehow affected them.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Hmmmm.... no. I feel like this wasn't their home...

GeminiRose: *MSG* but that it was related to them. Crops maybe?

Lily: *MSG* Hmm, years later, my grandparents' house that they raised their kids in burned down. This was after they had passed, though.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Okay. That makes sense then.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Did you spend much time with them?

GeminiRose: *MSG* I feel like this has all been quite some time ago.

GeminiRose: *MSG* They're also showing me the horses.

Lily: *MSG* Yes, with both sets. We lived first with my father's

family, and then with my mother's.

Lily: *MSG* I used to ride horses on my uncle's farm in the summers when we visited.

...

GeminiRose: *MSG* Okay, I am getting the older gentleman with whom you sometimes took walks.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I feel like I'm still in more of a rural setting.

Lily: *MSG* Oh! Grandpa.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I see a bridge.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Like we walk to the bridge,

GeminiRose: *MSG* have our little talks, [and]

GeminiRose: *MSG* enjoy each other's time.

Lily: *MSG* He was my favorite. I loved him very much.

GeminiRose: *MSG* This person was one you learned a lot about life from.

Lily: *MSG* He was my mom's dad.

Lily: *MSG* Yep.

GeminiRose: *MSG* He always had a good story to share with you or words of wisdom.

Lily: *MSG* He did.

GeminiRose: *MSG* But I don't feel like he was really open and loud.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Like, he reserved that part of himself

GeminiRose: *MSG* for specific people.

GeminiRose: *MSG* He shared that inner wisdom with you.

Lily: *MSG* He related to me like a person, not a kid.

Lily: *MSG* No, he was very quiet.

GeminiRose: *MSG* You two have a different connection.

GeminiRose: *MSG* He could open up to you and felt more at peace doing so.

Lily: *MSG* I think so, too.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Even though you were much younger.

GeminiRose: *MSG* ... You guys [have] incarnated together before.

GeminiRose: *MSG* You've been the same age in lifetimes past.

GeminiRose: *MSG* That's why he felt so comfortable with you on that level.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Good grief- more with the vegetables.

Lily: *MSG* We really had a bond; still do, in fact.

Lily: *MSG* I believe that.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Now I'm seeing corn. LOL!

GeminiRose: *MSG* ...Cornfields.

Lily: *MSG* They did grow a lot of stuff.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Wow.... you come from a very rural... ummm...

agricultural background.

Lily: *MSG* Veggies, fruits, berries.

Lily: *MSG* Yes.

GeminiRose: *MSG* That's where you got so much of your spirituality.

GeminiRose: *MSG* You wouldn't have felt as comfortable in a city setting.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Even when you were there,

Lily: *MSG* Fields, orchards, chickens, pigs...

GeminiRose: *MSG* that part of you longed for that earth connection.

Lily: *MSG* That's likely very true.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Who's the California connection The one with the vineyards.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I'm getting grapes-

GeminiRose: *MSG* making wine.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Sparkling cider.

Lily: *MSG* Hmm, nobody in CA that I know, but again, there were so many, it's possible one ended up there.

Lily: *MSG* My granny made wines and brandy and all kinds of stuff, though.

Lily: *MSG* You know, I'd actually forgotten all this growing stuff, and it seems significant that I recall it now.

...

GeminiRose: *MSG* okay. The one you walked with all the time.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Mother or father's side?

Lily: *MSG* That was grandpa Perkins, mom's dad.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Ok. Same one.

Lily: *MSG* Yeah, such a lovely man.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Did he try to teach you to play?

Lily: *MSG* He tried to, but I was hopeless. lol

GeminiRose: *MSG* I keep getting that seeing you with an instrument was like

GeminiRose: *MSG* "You shoulda' seen it. What a sight!"

Lily: *MSG* He would play, and I would sing silly nursery songs for company.

GeminiRose: *MSG* "Bless her heart, she tried, but it just didn't fit to her."

Lily: *MSG* Lol. He had a huge accordion, and he would let me hold it. It was way bigger than me.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Gosh, he is dominating the connection here,

GeminiRose: *MSG* but I just feel like he has such a bond to you,

GeminiRose: *MSG* Even now.

GeminiRose: *MSG* He says that he does guide you.

Lily: *MSG* He's not the dominating type, but we have a very strong connection.

GeminiRose: *MSG* It just came to me that I wonder if he is a guide to you now,

Lily: *MSG* I believe he does-

Lily: *MSG* and he says that he does help.

Lily: *MSG* and is.

Lily: *MSG* He sent me a sign of that a few years ago, in fact.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Yes, dominating in that your connection is stronger than the others.

...

GeminiRose: *MSG* Who's the female pianist?

GeminiRose: *MSG* This is the lady who played at church or for groups.

Lily: *MSG* My grandma and my mom both played.

GeminiRose: *MSG* She may have even given lessons.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I see her in a skirt and sweater just playing away.

Lily: *MSG* No, not formally anyway.

Lily: *MSG* She did love to play, though

GeminiRose: *MSG* Never in church?

GeminiRose: *MSG* Did she play church music?

GeminiRose: *MSG* Like, hymns n' stuff?

Lily: *MSG* Not that I can recall. (Regarding playing in church.)

Lily: *MSG* My grandma may have played hymns, but mom only liked pop music.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Did she sing when she played?

GeminiRose: *MSG* This woman is like belting out tunes-

GeminiRose: *MSG* maybe even show tunes.

Lily: *MSG* Yes, they could both sing.

GeminiRose: *MSG* like...

Lily: *MSG* "Suwannee?" lol

GeminiRose: *MSG* LOL

GeminiRose: *MSG* No... More like old time hymns and show tunes.

Lily: *MSG* That would have been more in Grandma's generation.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Where's the stage connection?

GeminiRose: *MSG* I really feel like there was someone that did this on stage.

Lily: *MSG* Well, I was a theater major in college

GeminiRose: *MSG* A performer at heart. Always the entertainer.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Okay, that makes sense.

Lily: *MSG* But nobody in the family that I know of was ever a

professional entertainer.

GeminiRose: *MSG* 'Cause I was always the same way. So I know a performer when I feel [one].

GeminiRose: *MSG* No, not necessarily professional

Lily: *MSG* My mother was a performer, though... In her own way...

GeminiRose: *MSG* but out in front of an audience.

Lily: *MSG* She was a Leo...

GeminiRose: *MSG* Always "on stage" even at home.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Ahh... that would explain that.

Lily: *MSG* Yeah, that would be her,

Lily: *MSG* and she knows I would get that reference.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I also get that she was a stickler for finances.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Like I feel like I am doing the budgeting.

Lily: *MSG* She was very good at paying the bills and keeping on budget.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Balancing the checkbook.

Lily: *MSG* Yes, very much so.

Lily: *MSG* She never had much, but she managed it always.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Like... she could pinch pennies and cut corners like nobody's business.

Lily: *MSG* Yep.

Lily: *MSG* She had to.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I also get that she taught the value of a dollar to her kids.

Lily: *MSG* She did that.

GeminiRose: *MSG* That was very important to her

GeminiRose: *MSG* that you guys knew how much it meant to have something,

Lily: *MSG* I learned that from her.

GeminiRose: *MSG* and that you never took anything of material value for granted.

Lily: *MSG* Very true.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Easy come easy go. (GeminiRose used this to refer to the cycle of money- a person can have it one day and lose it all the next.)

GeminiRose: *MSG* Like... you never know when you're gonna' have it again... save for a rainy day... Yada, yada.

Lily: *MSG* That was my father's way,

Lily: *MSG* not hers.

Lily: *MSG* Exactly.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Lily, did you dance when you were little?

GeminiRose: *MSG* I see you in a pink tutu, like, ballet outfit.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Is this something you always did at home?

Lily: *MSG* I wanted to, very much. I became a ballroom dancer when I was an adult, but it was too late then for ballet.

GeminiRose: *MSG* [It was } like.... you wanted a little audience to perform in front of...

Lily: *MSG* I always wanted to be a ballerina.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Okay that's the way she showed you to me:

Lily: *MSG* She was always dressing me up like a little doll.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Doing that move where you're on one leg with your arms out to the side. Your hair is back in a braid in the little ballet get up.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Did she make a big deal about Easter?

Lily: *MSG* Yes.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Easter was a big dress-up time.

GeminiRose: *MSG* The bonnet.

GeminiRose: *MSG* The dress.

Lily: *MSG* We had the new outfits, yes.

GeminiRose: *MSG* The tights and little... white shoes.

Lily: *MSG* I was christened at Easter.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Ahh... so it was an exceptionally special time then.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I mean, even more so than typical.

Lily: *MSG* It was always a big deal to her.

Lily: *MSG* Yeah, she could show off. lol

GeminiRose: *MSG* Was she somewhat of a social butterfly?

GeminiRose: *MSG* I was just gonna' say that!

Lily: *MSG* Oh yeah.

GeminiRose: *MSG* She took you around to show you off.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Lil' parties with the neighborhood mommies and their girls.

Lily: *MSG* Yes!

Lily: *MSG* That's just how it was

GeminiRose: *MSG* LOL!

GeminiRose: *MSG* She ate it up.

GeminiRose: *MSG* You were always complimented too.

Lily: *MSG* She used to love dressing me to the nines and going out to town.

Lily: *MSG* Yes, she loved that!

GeminiRose: *MSG* Like, "Oh isn't she just precious!"

GeminiRose: *MSG* ... I think you really [did] personify your name.

Lily: *MSG* Yeah, I was her little dolly baby.

Lily: *MSG* She was very young then, just 20.

GeminiRose: *MSG* She makes me feel like we're rushing to get to this engagement

GeminiRose: *MSG* and to that one.

Lily: *MSG* She was very social

GeminiRose: *MSG* Oh my.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I also feel like I'm punctual, but just barely.

Lily: *MSG* Mmhmm

GeminiRose: *MSG* Like, I'll get there at the very last minute that I can to be considered on time.

Lily: *MSG* Punctuality was instilled in everyone by Grandma.

Lily: *MSG* I always get there early, [but]

Lily: *MSG* she would run in breathless.

GeminiRose: *MSG* LOL

GeminiRose: *MSG* Hehehe that's what I see, but on time!

Lily: *MSG* Yep, because nobody was late in my Grandma's family!

GeminiRose: *MSG* I'm seeing a waterfall.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I feel like this is a trip you took

GeminiRose: *MSG* to see the waterfalls.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Something much anticipated.

Lily: *MSG* Could be. I've done that more than once.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Have you visited your brother in Canada?

GeminiRose: *MSG* Is that where you [saw the falls]?

Lily: *MSG* I love water and falls.

GeminiRose: *MSG* She wasn't there for the waterfall trips, though.

Lily: *MSG* I have, [visited my brother], but not since '95.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I get that she was there, but not physically.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Is that correct?

Lily: *MSG* I went to Bushkill Falls in PA a few years ago.

Lily: *MSG* Oh, that could be.

Lily: *MSG* She does hang with us.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I (GeminiRose is referring to Lily's mother.) feel like I was sharing a quiet, peaceful moment with you.

Lily: *MSG* And that [trip] was right after she died.

Lily: *MSG* That could very well be. (Regarding the sharing of a peaceful moment)

GeminiRose: *MSG* I keep seeing the one that looks like that Kinkaid painting

with the waterfall.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Know which one I'm talking about?

Lily: *MSG* When I was there, I went on my own for a walk and did a little meditation.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I don't know. Maybe waterfalls all look the same. I've not been to one before.

Lily: *MSG* Yeah, I do know the one.

Lily: *MSG* They're all beautiful. :)

GeminiRose: *MSG* The one that looked most like that.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Were you standing behind the waterfall at some point?

GeminiRose: *MSG* Like, could you stand under one and still see another?

Lily: *MSG* Yes, there were 4 of them there.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Gosh, I guess that would mean there would have to be [at least] two.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Ahh okay.

GeminiRose: *MSG* She was there at that time with you.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Was she never able to do that during life?

Lily: *MSG* Cool, that's good to know.

Lily: *MSG* No, we never travelled together.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I feel like that was something that she just enjoyed sharing with you so much.

Lily: *MSG* I'm glad she did.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Was your son with you then?

Lily: *MSG* Yes, and my daughter.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Okay they were physically there at the site, right?

Lily: *MSG* Yeah.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Cause she wants me to acknowledge that.

GeminiRose: *MSG* ... I get that feeling like I just can't get enough of that [being with the kids].

Lily: *MSG* We lived far apart so she didn't see them that often.

GeminiRose: *MSG* So she REALLY DIDN'T get to baby them as much as she'd [have] liked.

GeminiRose: *MSG* She wanted to get her hands on your daughter and dress her up too?

Lily: *MSG* I know she is around now because she's not limited by physical distance.

GeminiRose: *MSG* You didn't really do that too much, though, did you?

Lily: *MSG* She did want to, I'm sure.

...

Lily: *MSG* No, I didn't inflict on my daughter that kind of fussiness

because I hated it myself.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Grandpa Joe?

Lily: *MSG* Oh my! That would be Great Grandpa!

GeminiRose: *MSG* Okay, well, he's saying "hi".

Lily: *MSG* I only met him once, and he gave me a silver dollar that I still have.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Was he the one that smoked a pipe?

Lily: *MSG* Tell him I remember him. Yes, he did.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I think he gets that. Lol

Lily: *MSG* That's good.

GeminiRose: *MSG* He was very sophisticated...

Lily: *MSG* It feels nice to have all these people around me; I feel their energy too.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I see an older gentleman, a true gentleman, in like a tweed coat, tan in color; hat [and] he smokes a pipe.

Lily: *MSG* I didn't know him, really; I was 2 or 3 when I met him that one time.

Lily: *MSG* That does sound like my memory.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Who had the creepy attic?

GeminiRose: *MSG* You were fascinated with this attic.

Lily: *MSG* OH! Lol! That was my mom's mom.

GeminiRose: *MSG* You wanted to experience it,

GeminiRose: *MSG* but it creeped you out.

Lily: *MSG* I WAS [fascinated]! OMG!

GeminiRose: *MSG* You wanted to go in,

GeminiRose: *MSG* but you couldn't quite bring yourself to.

Lily: *MSG* I wanted to badly get up there!

GeminiRose: *MSG* You'd stand at the door and try to work up the courage

GeminiRose: *MSG* but you just couldn't do it.

GeminiRose: *MSG* You'd fight inside your brain...

Lily: *MSG* I was halfway up the stairs by [the time my grandmother] caught me.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Trying to talk yourself out of the fear.

GeminiRose: *MSG* LOL

Lily: *MSG* I really was fascinated by it.

GeminiRose: *MSG* She wouldn't let you go in?

Lily: *MSG* No.

GeminiRose: *MSG* It was dangerous.

Lily: *MSG* She said it wasn't safe up there.

Lily: *MSG* I don't know why.

GeminiRose: *MSG* The floors weren't good.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I think it was [because of the] floors and all the endless junk you could get into. :)

Lily: *MSG* I suspect she was sensitive and there may have been a ghost there.

Lily: *MSG* Maybe so.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I think that may have been your fascination with it.

Lily: *MSG* But *something* called to me from that attic.

Lily: *MSG* It's so trippy that you got that! Lol

GeminiRose: *MSG* Was she the same one who was always shoving snacks at you?

Lily: *MSG* YES!

GeminiRose: *MSG* ... "Here, kid, have a banana."

Lily: *MSG* lol

GeminiRose: *MSG* "Take this banana, it's good for you."

Lily: *MSG* I was so scrawny! She was trying to fatten me up.

GeminiRose: *MSG* "Your body needs to be healthy. You don't eat enough."

Lily: *MSG* She made me the most yummy stuff!

Lily: *MSG* She was an incredible baker.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Did she always do the baking for parties?

Lily: *MSG* Always.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Family get-togethers.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Birthday parties.

GeminiRose: *MSG* She decorated cakes and all that stuff?

Lily: *MSG* At this time of year, she baked from morning to night for weeks.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Everyone looked forward to what she was gonna' make.

Lily: *MSG* Oh yeah, she was amazing in the kitchen.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Like she and her goodies would have been long awaited for.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Did she also cook Italian food?

Lily: *MSG* No, not Italian.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I get... like... making meatballs.

GeminiRose: *MSG* is this someone else?

GeminiRose: *MSG* Someone whose dinner dishes

GeminiRose: *MSG* could rival the cakes?

GeminiRose: *MSG* Who was responsible for bringing the main dishes?

GeminiRose: *MSG* I feel a rivalry here, Lily.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Like one older lady trying to outdo the other.....

Lily: *MSG* Yes, between the two grannies.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Hahaha!

Lily: *MSG* Oh [heck] yeah!

GeminiRose: *MSG* Okay... Like "I'm so gonna' outdo her this year!"

Lily: *MSG* Both of them were great cooks,

GeminiRose: *MSG* I don't feel [as though] it was really pronounced, but the rivalry was definitely there.

Lily: *MSG* and they did try to outdo one another.

Lily: *MSG* Oh yeah.

Lily: *MSG* Not out of malice, but [out of] pride in their ability.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Did you have a cousin pass away as a child?

Lily: *MSG* More than one, yes.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Okay, male?

GeminiRose: *MSG* They're bringing up your cousin

Lily: *MSG* Yes.

GeminiRose: *MSG* that passed in childhood.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Tell me if the physical description is right:

Lily: *MSG* Oh, I didn't know him, but I knew that he had died.

GeminiRose: *MSG* I see him with fair skin.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Dark hair-

GeminiRose: *MSG* Kind of messy looking hair.

Lily: *MSG* From the photos, yes.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Okay, they're bringing him up.

Lily: *MSG* He was my aunt's son.

GeminiRose: *MSG* There was something unusual about the way your family handled his passing

GeminiRose: *MSG* or funeral.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Did they have a big dinner or something?

GeminiRose: *MSG* Or did these ladies cook in his honor?

Lily: *MSG* That wouldn't surprise me.

GeminiRose: *MSG* Is that something they would typically do?

GeminiRose: *MSG* I mean, I feel [as though] there was a funeral, but there was a separate occasion they had to commemorate him.

Lily: *MSG* Although it was when I was very little and I don't remember. I only heard about him in passing.

Lily: *MSG* They might very well [have done] that.

...

GeminiRose: *MSG* Who was hit by a semi?

GeminiRose: *MSG* I feel like a big semi truck is headed right for me.
Lily: *MSG* hit and killed, you mean?
GeminiRose: *MSG* I don't know.... if they were killed...
GeminiRose: *MSG* I would assume so, but it could just be to point out someone else in your life.
Lily: *MSG* I got hit by one, or my car did, a few years back.
GeminiRose: *MSG* I just see the semi headed for me and I feel like it's gonna' hit me.
GeminiRose: *MSG* Okay... so you weren't in it?
GeminiRose: *MSG* Like... that's why there wouldn't be injury
GeminiRose: *MSG* but the car was hit?
Lily: *MSG* I was! It ripped off the side mirror and half the driver's door, and I was sitting there freaking out!
GeminiRose: *MSG* Holy [crap]!
Lily: *MSG* I always said someone was watching out for me that day.
Lily: *MSG* It scared me badly. To this day I don't drive on the freeway.
